Made by the famed Chateaneuf du Pape producer Mas de Boislauzon, this value oriented red table wine is fruity with enough decent fruit structure and acidity to stand up to the heartiest of foods.

Emily's Notes: While this wine was acceptable to drink on it's own, it really changed and became more complex when consumed with food. I definately suggest serving with spicy pork or a juicy steak to get the most out of this wine.
