Maison L'Aiglon Saint-Chinian - \$10 France

Tasting Notes: M aison l'A iglon is produced from traditional Languedoc grapes such as Grenache, Syrah, and Carignan. The combination of these grapes with the fermentation in stainless steel tanks, plus slight aging in oak barrels gives this wine similar characteristics of famous Cotes-du-Rhone Wines. Well rounded and fruity with a deep ruby color. Smooth and not too heavy for these hot summer days. Great for an evening by the grill.

Pair with: Anything off the grill.

GRAVINA BOTROMAGNO BIANCO - \$10

PUGLIA, ITALY

About Gravina: Gravina is one of the oldest white wines in Italy. Its production can be traced back to the 6th century B.C. when the vines, imported from “M anga Grecia” (the name of the area in Southern Italy and Sicily that was colonized by Greek settlers in the 8th century B.C.), found their perfect habitat in Puglia. Granted D O C status in 1983, Gravina is produced exclusively by Botrom agno.

Tasting Notes: Pale-yellow in color with green reflections, Gravina Bianco displays aromas of tropical fruits and white flowers followed by notes of citrus and green apple. With a long finish it is a good match for raw fish, and spicy dishes.
