Revelry Cabernet - A GREAT VALUE at \$10

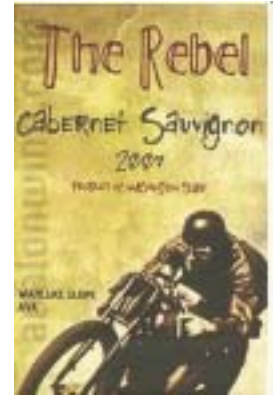
This new vintage of the Revelry Cabernet is fantastic. Dark berry notes with hints of vanilla and oak, it's an easy sipper for these cool winter nights.
