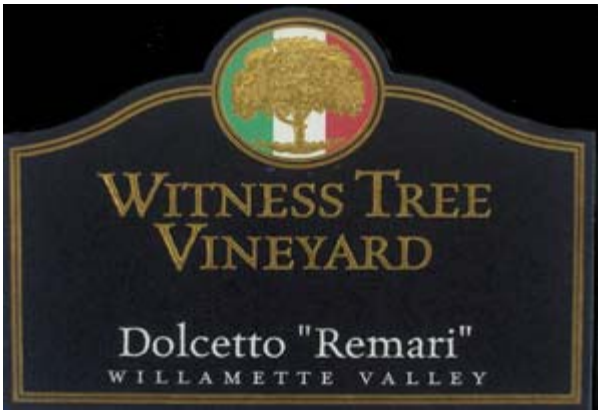

Witness Tree "Remari" Dolcetto - \$20 Willamette Valley, Oregon

Named in honor of the owners' granddaughters—Remi and Mari—the Dolcetto comes from a 1.6 acre site that we like to refer to as an experiment gone right! Native to the Piedmont region in Northern Italy, the Dolcetto grape exhibits big grapey, sassy flavors! Its considerable "slurpy factor" makes it a wonderful cocktail wine, while its natural acidity gives it the power to pair exceptionally well with all kinds of cuisine. 98 Cases Produced

Emily's Notes: This is the kind of wine that isn't too serious, but has loads of good flavors and is fun to drink.

Damien Laureau "Les Genets" Savennieres - \$25

Called "undoubtedly the future star of Savennieres" by France's "La Revue de Vin du France", Damien Laureau selects the Savennieres for this wine at the highest elevation vineyards. It is 100% Chenin Blanc with aromatics and flavors that will knock your socks off. But, the balance and acidity blend well and make for an incredible wine.



Serve with: It's a lovely wine to sip on it's own, but it will go nicely with salads and some spicy foods.
